(c) Planning Monitoring

Lavington Lane site – a spring has sprung in the access road by the entrance to the site, which has delayed tarmac work.

Following a website enquiry from a member of the public regarding the removal of some small trees at the corner of the site we have received the following reply from the Site Manager of the Hayfield site.

"As you rightly pointed out below the trees were in the area for our water Temporary Building Supply. They are also in the location on

our plans for our soil connections and foundations for plots 21-22 so unfortunately they could not remain in place.

It would always be our first decision to leave trees in place where we can so prior to removing the trees I asked our technical department to investigate the Tree Preservation Orders and look into any prohibitions on site. They confirmed back to me that the oak trees were not under a Tree Preservation Order.

The sign on the fencing had been placed there incorrectly by the fencers who had initially set up the site as we thought they may turn out to be protected so wanted to be on the safe side. Please note our planting scheme on site currently has over 200 trees that are between 3m and 6m in height once fully mature with a huge array of additional smaller trees and hedging which should bring the country feel back into the area."

Chair of Parish Council has requested a 4 minute presentation slot at the meeting of the Eastern Area Planning Committee on Thursday 8 September.

Tree Preservation Orders – update: The Haven in Littleton Panell is for sale with a suggestion that there is space for a building plot. Concern expressed that the mature specimen trees might be at risk. David Wyatt (WC officer) contacted by Chair to request him to visit the site and advise. He said they would have protection in Conservation Area and he would look out for any future planning applications at this location.
