# Buses serving Potterne, West Lavington, Market Lavington, Easterton and Urchfont during the Potterne road closure on 20, 21, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 January 2022.



On 20, 21, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 January, the A360 road from West Lavington and Potterne to Devizes will be closed south of Devizes between 7am and 6pm. During this time, Salisbury Reds bus service 2 and Faresaver bus services 77, 87 and 270 will be unable to follow their normal route and timetable, so special arrangements will apply to these services as explained in this leaflet. Details of buses through Potterne on these dates are shown below, whilst those through Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons are shown overleaf (services will run normally at weekends):

#### **Buses from Potterne to Devizes**

Whilst the road is closed, Salisbury Reds bus service 2 will be unable to call at Potterne, so the route of Faresaver service 270 will be altered so that it can provide a shuttle service between Potterne and Devizes as follows:

### **Buses from Devizes and Potterne to Salisbury**

Whilst the road is closed, Salisbury Reds bus service 2 will be unable to call at Potterne after 0730 (special arrangements have been made for the early morning bus to pass through the closure).

The 0705 bus from Devizes will follow its normal route and timetable, but after this time, buses on service 2 will depart from Devizes 15 minutes later than usual and will then run via Urchfont instead of Potterne. This means that after 0730 they will not be able to pick up at the bus stop near Wick Lane in Devizes, or in Potterne village.

Buses from Salisbury will depart from the City Centre at the normal time, but will run via Urchfont instead of Potterne until 1800 (6pm). This means that the only bus from Salisbury to Potterne will be at 1740.

# Buses from Potterne to Trowbridge

The road closure will also affect bus service 77 and 87 and so these services will run slightly differently.

The first service 77 bus in the morning will continue to pick up in Potterne at 0745, but other journeys will run slightly differently.

# Buses from Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons to Devizes during the Potterne road closure

On 20, 21, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 January, Salisbury Reds bus service 2 and Faresaver bus service 270 will be unable to follow their normal route and timetable due to the closure of the A360 road at Potterne for repairs.

This means that between 7.30am and 5.45pm on these dates, bus service 2 will be diverted via Urchfont, Easterton and Market Lavington High Street and will mostly replace bus service 270 between these times. The times of buses between Devizes, Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons during this time will therefore be as follows:

## Buses will return from Devizes Market Place (Bus Island) to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons at the following times:

0705 - service 2 to Potterne and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury - NOT via Urchfont or Easterton

0715 - service 87 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons, then to Trowbridge

0742 - service 270 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons (including Lavington School)

0905 - service 2 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury

1025 - service 2 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury

1125 - service 2 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury

1225 - service 2 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury

**1325** - service 2 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury

**1425** - service 2 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury

**1520** - service 2 to Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury

**1610** - service 270 to Worton, Potterne, the Lavingtons, then to Potterne and Devizes

1735 - service 270 to Urchfont, Easterton, the Lavingtons, Easterton, Urchfont, then back to Devizes

1755 - service 2 to Potterne and the Lavingtons, then to Salisbury - NOT via Urchfont or Easterton

During this period, Salisbury Reds and Faresaver drivers will accept day return,10-journey and season tickets issued by either company for travel between Devizes, Urchfont, Easterton and the Lavingtons. However we regret that Salisbury Reds drivers will not be able to issue transfer tickets onto Faresaver service 272 to Bath.

Please note that buses will run normally on Saturdays and Sunday during this period as the road will be open at weekends.

#### **Travelling from the Lavingtons to Salisbury?**

Please note that whilst the road is closed, Salisbury Reds buses will depart at their normal times from Salisbury, but will be delayed by diversion. This means that so after 7.30am, buses on service 2 will depart from Devizes 15 mins later than normal and from West Lavington 30 minutes later.
