	SIDs in place and councillors have received an email on how to access date from them. There was a noticeable slowing in traffic when the devices were turned on. They are battery powered and we have spare batteries.			
	A skip will be required to clear the greenery from the cutting back of Robert's Playground. The cost will be around £200 to £250.

Wiltshire Councillors report 25/26/079 Cllr Muns reported: Black Dog: works starting imminently, with an estimated completion in February. 8 Russell Mill Lane: Nothing further heard. Wiltshire Council Adult Social Care will be writing to surrounding residents to make them aware that someone is moving in and providing a point of contact. White Street proposed development: Nothing further heard. Church Street SIDs are now in place. Car Park issues in Hayfield, which requires a larger parish council discussion so it will be included as part of the Village Hall update. **Public Participation** 25/26/080 A Street Scene representative thanked the parish council for the previous grants and reported: "Over 30 planters now in villages, with more volunteers joining. Last year, nine new planters were positioned, some replacing old ones, four in new locations. This year, eight were replaced with four in new locations, three of which had to be purchased from a company, which put a considerable strain on our funds. We are continuing to expand with new areas planned. The aim is to be inclusive of all new residents who have moved to the villages, providing a colourful experience for all. We have enough wood to make four more, which will be an autumn-early spring project. We have the manpower in place to execute this. Also, the materials very generously donated again by Jewson's of Devizes. Funds became very low this summer, as buying compost and plants to fill them is expensive. As a result of this, sponsorship deals have been arranged for local businesses in return for advertising on a planter. We are very grateful for the support from the Parish Council, for which all these achievements would not have been possible without it, so we hope this can continue." NHP (Neighbourhood Plan) Review Group - Housing Needs Survey in 2025 Cllr Pattisson reported that the existing draft plan (and its policies) is very good. There is still uncertainty as to whether we need to put in more locations where we agree more housing can be built, although this is dependent on how many houses we are required to build. The current figure is believed to be 58. Do we send this plan in for approval, or do we do additional work to get the plan to a level that Wiltshire Council would be happy with, which could involve environmental assessment, for which funding may be available? Rights of Way Cllr Harrison reported that the Lavington Landscape event two weeks ago had a good turnout, and all the Rights of Way are now accessible. Two items to be worked on: 1/ Connecting the village in the north. 2/ Bottom of footpath by the bridge, on WLAV 1 where it meets A360 needs some sort of barrier to protect pedestrians from cars. Two footpaths at the Rutts Lane, both of which start at the top of the embankment. One of them heads Southwest along the A360 and is useless because it leads to a blind corner with no footpath on the side of the A360. The other one goes north from Southeast and comes back to the top of Stibb Hill and is also inaccessible. Cllr Harrison is in discussions with the Access Officer to find a solution. Cllr Harrison suggested a leaflet/handout which would include a map of the footpaths on one side and a Welcome to the Village pack on the other side.
